Sacred Heart Community Food Pantry

We would like to take a moment to share with you what we've been doing. In the past fiscal year we have:

- With the help of our 30 some courageous volunteers procured, shelved, and distributed well in excess of 45,000 pounds of food to our community.
- Welcomed 1,804 visitors to the pantry allowing us to reach 3,768 persons with food.
- Increased the contents of our monthly shelf stable bags from fifteen to twenty items.
- Added the basic essentials of bread, milk, eggs and cheese to our first Tuesday pantry pick-up.
- Recently added the second Friday of each month as a day to distribute free produce and meat from the Kansas Food Bank.
- With the help of grants from local community organizations sustained our weekly fresh produce program and increased our holiday turkey give away to include entire (make it yourself) Thanksgiving Dinner.
- Thanks in large part to the Frontenac High School Food Drive reduced the cost of our shelf stable bags by 50% and at the same time substantially increased the number of families we serve.
- Welcomed Teresa Bishop as our new secretary and Lori Mendicki as our volunteer coordinator. Anna Terlip will continue to volunteer as our grant request writer and Virginia Hamisak as a bagger. Many thanks for your service.

We are currently serving over 100 families per month. 44% of our clients are seniors. As pantry volunteers we are grateful for the friendships we have developed with each other and with our clients. We no longer serve strangers waiting in a food line. We serve our neighbors and friends. **We sincerely appreciate your continued support and look forward to another successful year.**
