Sacred Heart Community Food Pantry

We would like to take a moment to express our gratitude for the generous donations you are making in support of the Sacred Heart Food Pantry. In response we would like to share with you what we are doing.

We are experiencing a phenomenal increase in need. In 2021, the pantry provided an average of 53 bags of groceries per month to those in need. We are currently providing over 150 bags of groceries to approximately 90 families per month. Last week alone we served 63 families welcoming 13 new families to our pantry.

In order to respond to the increasing need we have made several changes. We have learned that in many cases we can shop locally spending less than we would if securing the food from the food bank in Wichita. We are manipulating how we fill the bags based on cost, availability, number of meals and nutrition. We are also pursuing several grants.

We are currently purchasing fresh produce with a grant we recently received. The grant money will allow use to continue offering produce for another six or seven weeks at which time we will need to curtail this service. For the past six months we have made good use of the approximately 14,000 items of shelf stable food we received from the Frontenac High School food drive.

Having substantially depleted that donation we will, beginning September 1st, begin limiting our guest to one bag of groceries per month. We believe that these changes will allow us to continue serving those in need with some relief. Thank you again for your support!
