

Year-End Tithing Opportunity

Estimates have been collected for Church renovations which we plan to begin in the Spring of 2023. If you would like to make your donation in 2022 for tax purposes, we will set aside those funds for the renovation project. The following estimates have been collected to date: Pews & Kneelers- \$63, 954, Tile Flooring & Carpet under pews- \$61, 836, Design, Painting of Church interior (walls, ceiling, and interior architectural features), altars, stations & statuary (\$50,000 to \$70,000) and the necessary scaffolding \$39,902.
