“FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES” Consider leprosy. This disease affected a person’s skin outwardly, and inwardly caused great amounts of pain. A leper quickly became a social outcast. In today’s gospel, Jesus heals a man with leprosy — an incurable disease that would have led to the man’s death. As you read this gospel passage, you may have had feelings of gratitude that we are not surrounded with this disease today. But let’s liken leprosy to sin. Sin causes a sort of “spiritual leprosy” that causes great suffering and ultimately leads to a spiritual death. It is only curable by Jesus, and like the leper, we need only cry out to Jesus: “If you wish, you can make me clean.” In the Sacrament of Reconciliation, Jesus says to us, “Be made clean.” In the confessional, Jesus reaches out His hand, touching our souls and making us new again. We can’t possibly grow as disciples if our souls are dying. As we approach the Lenten season, kneel down and beg Jesus to heal you — and have faith that He will!
