

Sacred Heart Food Pantry Update

Very generous donors and hard working and dedicated volunteers have made 2022 an extra-special year for the food pantry. Thank you to all!

In the past six months we have distributed over 7,200 pounds of fresh produce and 9,600 pounds of shelf stable food. That's nearly 17,000 pounds of food that the pantry volunteers have acquired, sorted, packed and distributed.

In December, we welcomed 175 visitors to our pantry. Family demographics indicate that 33% of those we are reaching are seniors and 25% are children. Striving to provide the best possible food, while staying within our budget, we purchase fresh vegetables and fruit which brings great joy and good nutrition to all clients but most of all, by allowing all to come in and visit before we open, a community has been created whose stories, appreciation and laughter is nothing short of a holy moment.

2023 promises to be another extra-special year as we are in the process of establishing, through the Kansas Food Bank, a community food box program that will provide to seniors who qualify financially, an extra box of food monthly. With very careful budgeting of your continued generous support, we hope to provide our clients with special items not previously included, each month such as eggs, cheese or butter.

We also hope to provide them with the usual Thanksgiving and Christmas meal bags as well as an Easter surprise which will be new to our efforts this year. Again, this a tribute to all who give of their time, treasure and talent. Thank you!

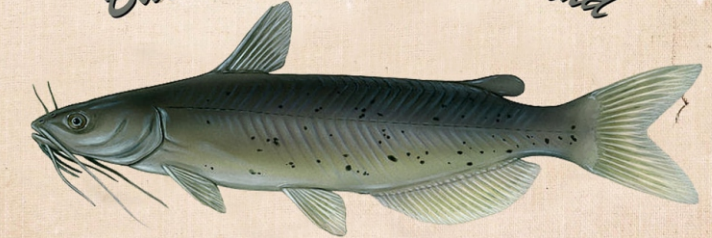

The Stations of the Cross are a 14-step Catholic devotion that commemorates Jesus Christ's last day on Earth as a man. The 14 devotions, or stations, focus on specific events of His last day, beginning with His condemnation. The stations are commonly used as a mini pilgrimage as the individual moves from station to station. At each station, the individual recalls and meditates on a specific event from Christ's last day.

Join us each Friday of Lent in the Church as we pray this devotion.
