
Man Fully Alive Men's Conference



PICK — Within the season of Lent, there are three foundational practices for maturing our relationship with Jesus: prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. These provide the structure for which you may be called to deepen your relationship with the Lord.

PERSEVERE — As you walk through this Lenten season, ask yourself if your practices are bringing you closer to Jesus. Remind yourself that the only way we can truly be saved is by Him—our lenten activities serve as a path towards ever—deepening connection with Christ. Lean on the Lord throughout the journey; persevere in faith knowing whatever practice(s) you have chosen go beyond just giving up something; they move us into greater intimacy and awareness of God's passion for humanity.

The Stations of the Cross are a 14-step Catholic devotion that commemorates Jesus Christ's last day on Earth as a man. The 14 devotions, or stations, focus on specific events of His last day, beginning with His condemnation. The stations are commonly used as a mini pilgrimage as the individual moves from station to station. At each station, the individual recalls and meditates on a specific event from Christ's last day.

Join us each Friday of Lent in the Church as we pray this devotion.
