"FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES" Today we remember the Baptism of Jesus, which sets the example for our own initiation into discipleship. Obviously, your Baptism was a step you made toward a lifelong relationship with God; it was the beginning of your FIAT. Have you ever considered, though, that God is also taking steps toward you? In today's gospel, John the Baptist says, "One mightier than I is coming after me." What he means is that the Christ will soon arrive on the scene, and He will change everything. But let's consider the phrase "coming after me" in another context. How often do you imagine God pursuing you? How comfortable are you with this idea? Are you inviting Him into your discipleship, or are you determined to do the work — even His work — on your own? In this passage, we hear the voice of God the Father at Jesus' baptism, and we see "the Spirit, like a dove, descending upon him." God is physically present! God draws near to us all in this way. FIAT means "let it be done"... it is time we submit ourselves to the will of God and live in confidence that God is coming after us!

Reminder: If you or your loved one is in need of anointing, please let Father know as soon as possible. There are many restrictions because of COVID-19, but it is possible in some situations for Father to anoint, or arrange for the hospital priest on call to be contacted.

Important: At this time, attendance numbers do not justify having the noon Mass on Sunday. Therefore, the noon Mass has been discontinued.

Communion: Starting on <u>Sunday, Oct. 25th</u>, Father will distribute Communion in the parking lot after all weekend Masses at approximately 5:45 pm on Saturdays, 8:45, and 10:45 on Sundays to those who cannot attend Mass in person at this time.
