**"FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES"** "He said to them, 'Come, and you will see." In today's gospel, Jesus invites us into His space. Discipleship does not happen from afar. Relationship with Jesus, as with others, often *begins* from afar, but Jesus acknowledges—even anticipates— our curiosity and draws us in. In today's first reading, Samuel, who is unfamiliar with the LORD, hears a voice calling to him in his sleep. Perhaps this is how Jesus reaches out to you — with quiet and persistent subtlety. In the gospel, Jesus looks directly at the disciples and invites them to follow Him. Maybe Jesus has been this blatant in His call to you. Regardless of how He reaches out to you, your FIAT begins when you respond to Jesus' invitation to come and see.

**Reminder:** If you or your loved one is in need of anointing, please let Father know as soon as possible. There are many restrictions because of COVID-19, but it is possible in some situations for Father to anoint, or arrange for the hospital priest on call to be contacted.
