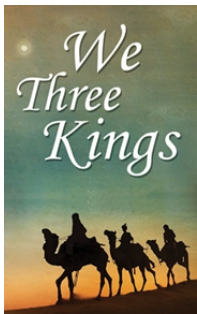
Eucharistic Adorer Needed
