The bus trip will stop at the Cross of Our Lord Jesus Christ in Amarillo, Texas, Carlsbad Caverns National Park, White Sands National Park, the Loretto Chapel in Santa Fe, New Mexico, sits in Taos, and a ride on the Cumbres & Toltec Railroad in Alamosa, Colorado.
