Sacred Heart Community Food Pantry

The Sacred Heart Community Food Pantry had another busy month in June serving 73 families. We handed out 155 bags of food as well as fresh fruit and vegetables. On June 30th we received the funding from the first of three grants that were written in 2022. This grant came to us from the Pittsburg Knights of Columbus. When the Pittsburg Knights of Columbus sold the towers last year an endowment fund was created with the proceeds. There were 16 applications received and a total of nearly \$54,000 was distributed to only ten organizations. Our food pantry was one of the ten and we received \$2,000. This will help fund our produce program for several weeks. Our thanks goes out to the Pittsburg Knights of Columbus and the Southeast Kansas Community Foundation for the funding. ~ David Close, Director.
