“FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES” “Whoever loves his life, loses it.” More than once, Jesus says something along these lines, but what does He mean? In today’s gospel, Jesus says that a grain of wheat must fall to the ground and die in order to produce fruit. What does this mean for us? In short, it means saying no to self and yes to God. *Fiat.* As Christian disciples, we only have to look to the lives of the saints to see the truth in this. Jesus challenges each of us to live a life fully devoted to Him. We do this through prayer, by serving one another, and by putting our own desires aside. When we love our lives too much, we become secure and selfish. It is only by stepping out of our comfort that we begin to produce real fruit. The grain of wheat is most comfortable atop its stalk, but it will never be more than a grain of wheat in that position. True discipleship begins when we risk the leap into the unknown, trusting that God’s purpose for us is much greater than our own.
