

Living the Joy of the Resurrection

On Easter Sunday and throughout the Easter season, we celebrate the Resurrection of Christ. As the disciples and other followers of Christ realized that He had risen, all were filled with overwhelming joy. They understood that Jesus' rising from the dead was the undeniable testimony that He was the Messiah. Filled with this joy, their lives were forever changed. Jesus invites each of us to share in this same joy.

Keeping this joy alive in our hearts will depend on how we approach each day. Here is a simple phrase to guide you. Live each day as if it were your first day, your last day, your only day.

Your first day. Whenever we experience something for the first time, we hold on to it and remember it. For in those moments, we are excited and share the news with family and friends. When we recall those moments, we are again filled with the same enthusiasm. It is with the same enthusiasm that God wants us to approach each day. No matter what the day brings, if we recognize that it is a gift from God, we will find his joy present in our hearts.

Your Last Day. As we advance in years, we all begin to look back on our lives. We reflect on our achievements, our failures, our successes, and our disappointments. Some will bring us discouragement and others will bring us joy. What we often fail to recognize is that God's love is present in all things.



<u> Divine Mercy Sunday - April 7th</u>

The Divine Mercy Novena can be prayed any time but Jesus specifically asked for it to be prayed for the 9 days preceding the Feast of Divine Mercy Sunday, beginning with Day 1 on Good Friday, March 29th.

The Feast of **Divine Mercy Sunday is April 7th**, the week after Easter. The Feast will be celebrated from **3:00-4:00 pm in the church**. Recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet, Eucharistic Adoration, and Confessions will be heard.

Jesus promised complete forgiveness of sins and punishment for those who go to Confession within a week and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of Mercy.
