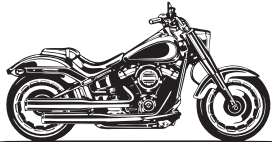
Memorial Day Mass and Legion Ceremony

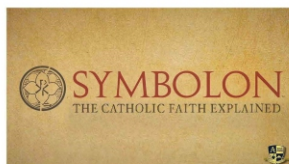
