Sacred Heart Community Food Pantry

Our food pantry volunteers have been quite busy! As of October 31st, we had 99 families who were receiving food. Our families included 110 adults, 41 children, and 48 seniors. We distributed food 137 times reaching 275 persons throughout the month.

We are pursuing a Federal grant program that will allow our qualifying clients over the age of 60 to receive a box of food monthly form the Commodity Supplemental Food Program of the USDA. Our pantry will distribute the boxes in conjunction with the Kansas Food Bank.

We are celebrating Thanksgiving with our clients by providing a turkey or ham along with a basket of food including fresh produce for their Thanksgiving dinner.


