

If you're asking how to have a great Advent, then let me ask: Are you preparing for a day or are you preparing for a person? Far too often in December our eyes are focused on a day: December 25<sup>th</sup> rather than a person—Jesus Christ, who was given to us on that day. If we prepare for a day rather than a person, then how



many times do you and I know that our lives can feel no more changed on December 26<sup>th</sup> than they were on December 24<sup>th</sup>? You desire more and we want more for you!

We are excited to invite you into a journey this Advent with a book titled Behold! This Advent we will go on a journey with Mary, Joseph, the child Jesus, and the Holy Family. We will let them speak to us about our lives and our experiences of childhood and beyond so that Jesus can bring us into wholeness and communion. This journey will take you to places of your heart...some joyful, some tender. That is okay. The Holy Family is in no hurry to rush you along or coerce you into anything. They are simply present to be with you, to lead you into all truth.

Each week of Behold will focus on a different theme that you can connect to your life in a practical way:

Week one: Motherhood—Receive Mary as your mother and let her tender love soften your heart toward your earthly mother;

Week two: Fatherhood—Adopt Joseph as your father and embrace his loving strength as you seek healing in your relationship with your own father;

Week three: Childhood—Become childlike with Jesus and remember the core of who you are as you release your inner joy and playfulness; and

**Week four**: Stable—Restore peace and unity in your family and regain hope.

Each day you will journey deeper into the meaning of Advent with a meditation, reflection questions, a prayer, and journaling space.
