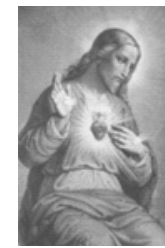

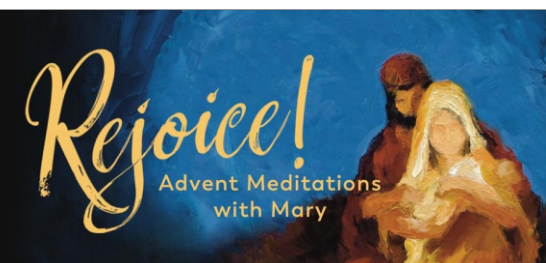

Thank you for supporting the DCCCA Pittsburg area youth in foster care this Christmas.

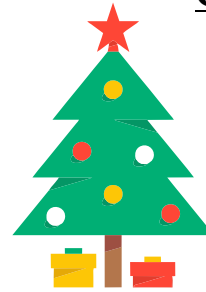
