Respect Life Giving Tree




Throughout the month of October our Respect Life Committee invites you to take a leaf from the Giving Tree and purchase the requested item. You may bring your baby gift and place it in the tub


provided or take it to the Parish Office during office hours. Our gift will then be donated to Vie Medical Clinic at the end of the month.
