Saturday, October 30th from 6:30 pm – 8:30 pm in the Parish parking lot. Come and decorate your trunk and fill it with candy!

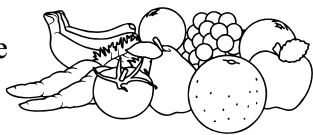
