We get into a habit of doing certain things, and don't venture beyond that. And, we live in a day and age when commitments are lacking in many areas of our lives.

Whenever we get into stewardship as a way of life, we make a commitment to do certain things for a certain period of time so we can change our mind after that time is up. So, we can volunteer for a year knowing it's not going to last longer than that, and we're not going to be stuck in a certain position for the rest of our life.

So, we need a renewal each year. We must also encourage those already living as faithful stewards, and remind them that they are truly appreciated. 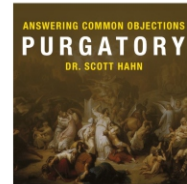
