Vatican International Exhibition
Eucharistic Miracles Of The World
at Our Lady of Lourdes

On Saturday, September 10th from 4:30 – 5:30 pm and Sunday, September 11th from 7:00 am – 2:00 pm, our Lady of Lourdes will host the display of Eucharistic Miracles of the World created by Blessed Carlos Acutis in the St. Mary's Elementary School commons area. About the Exhibit: An Italian teenager, Blessed Carlo Acutis, who was skilled in art and computers, put together the artwork and wording for this exhibit. Carlo completed this work in 2005 and died a year later of leukemia at the young age of 15. He was beatified "Blessed" by Pope Francis October 10, 2020, after being credited with curing a Brazilian boy from a rare pancreatic defect that made eating difficult.
