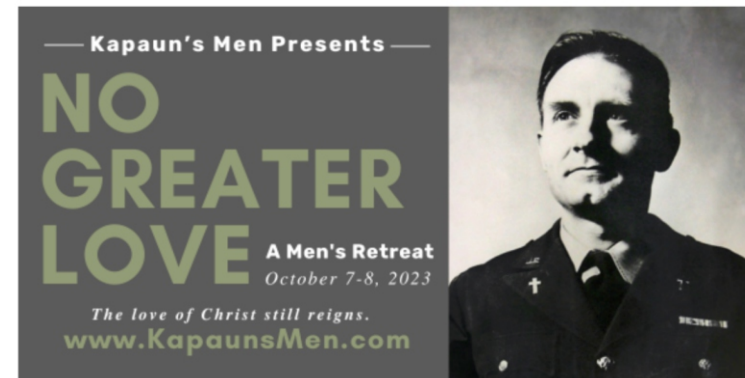
Respect Life Giving Tree
